# Corkage Fees \& Alcohol Policies 

\$12.00 each for bottle of wine<br>$\$ 120$ per case of wine ( 12 bottles) $\$ 30.00$ each case of beer ( 24 bottles or cans)<br>*No kegs or hard liquor (only available in Pali beverage packages)

- All alcohol must be checked in to the Event Services department upon check-in.
- Client will only be charged for alcohol that is consumed.
- Any remaining unopened alcohol may be taken home by the client at the end of their stay. Partial cases will be billed as whole cases upon check out.
- Hours of service must be predetermined by the Pali Retreat Event Services department and billed at $\$ 100.00$ / Hour / Bartender prior to the event.
- No alcohol may be brought on to Pali Retreat grounds, that is not dispensed by Pali Retreat Bartender.
- Alcohol can only be served during event/events, that are pre-approved by Pali Retreat Event Services department.
- Self-service of alcohol is NOT allowed.
- Alcohol is not allowed inside cabins or anywhere else on not specifically covered by the Pali Mountain Retreat liquor license.
- All alcohol (bottled and/or poured), must always be under the supervision of a Pali Retreat bartender.
- No alcoholic beverages may be removed from the event area.
- No alcohol may be served or consumed in glass containers at any event. This includes indoor \& outdoor events. All alcohol must be served in plastic cups. (Exceptions can be made with permission from Event Services)
- The serving to and/or the consumption of alcohol by persons under 21 years of age is not permitted.
- Alcohol service must be shut down 30 minutes before the end of event. (Last Call)
- Drunkenness will not be tolerated; violators will be asked to leave the property.
- It is the client's responsibility that all attendees are aware of Pali Retreat's alcohol policies.
- Failure to abide by these alcohol policies may result in the event being immediately terminated and all event guests being ejected from the property.
